

Kent and Medway Structure Plan

Kent County Council and Medway Council have jointly prepared proposals for the replacement of the above plan. If, and when, these plan proposals are adopted they will form part of the development plan for the Kent County Council and Medway Council areas. The development plan forms the basis for decisions on land use planning affecting that area.
